## LITERACY & TECH FAMILY NIGHT

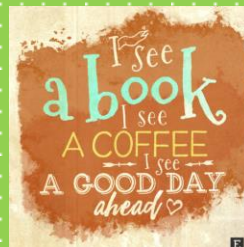

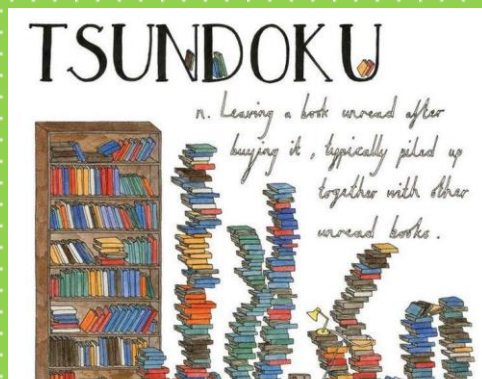
## EDPUZZLE - MAKE VIDEO ANY LESSON!

**EdPuzzle** is a free assessment-centered tool that allows teachers and students to create interactive online videos by embedding either open-ended or multiple-choice questions, audio notes, audio tracks, or comments on a video. Edpuzzle interactive videos can be made with videos from a number of websites, including YouTube, TED, Vimeo, and National Geographic. This is a great tool for teachers and students!



## DID YOU KNOW?

**Do you have a habit of picking up books that you never quite get around to reading?** If this sounds like you, you might be unwittingly engaging in **tsundoku** - a Japanese term used to describe a **person who owns a lot of unread literature**. The phrase 'tsundoku sensei' appears in text from 1879 according to the writer Mori Senzo, which is likely to be satirical, about **a teacher who has lots of books but doesn't read them**. ☺
